Page 807 (= "Catholic" ASCII) Strong's '07: Nun, Nurse, Nur-
ture, Oak Oars [Peter], Oath

Last week, on my birthday, I attended the Catholic service here in the Bear Loon Side chapel of USC F, so my friend Christian Fairbanks and I could sing/play our arrangement of "Oh Holy Night" for the closing song.

The next day, I tabulated the ASCII sum of "Catholic" = 807.

Page 807 of Str:07 (ISBN 978-1-59856-378-8) is loaded with relevance. The page heading (opening-closing) is "Numbered (cont.)-Oath", which relates to Catholic liturgy... which I experienced/witnessed/participated in last week.

After the Numbered (...) set of entries comes "Nun", (Joshua's father), which is about as Catholic term as there could be, besides "Pope". Similarly, the next entry is "Nurse," which profession was started by Catholics / Nuns. Likewise "Nurture" is likewise relevant to Catholic ethics generally, as epitomized by Mother Theresa.

Oak Oars calls to mind the fisherman, Peter.

Present at the 11/30 Catholic service, doing the singing of the chant lines, was ~~Mary~~ Annakate. The ASCII sum of "Anna" = 382, and "Kate" = 389, and "Annakate" = ~~803~~ ⁷⁷¹

(~~close to 802~~ w/space), no space. Those numbers show up on this page. "Nurture a 3809" (389); "Oath H 3728" (382 transposed); Oath 7621 (771, one digit ^{away} removed)

My ^{first} middle & last name show up in "Oar H 4880" (488 = "David" = "Allan"). More later. 840 = "Sterling".

Synchronistically, a few minutes after I finished the above article and had slipped it in an outgoing envelope to mail, I was watching (multi-tasking) OAN, One America News, Don Bell's "Red America" show. He was talking about the hair salon lady in OR, ^(had her on as guest) who Lindsey Graham, who was fined \$14k for opening her salon during the COVID lockdown. ^{A photo of her} She had a large tattoo on her left arm/shoulder, with "1 Samuel 1:27" on it. I was prompted to look that up. I turned to the index to find where 1 Sam. begins: p. 382 - "Anna" ASC II. 1222 is on the facing page, but on p. 382, the name "Hannah" (origin of Anna, see NT def. G 451, cites H 2584, Hannah) occurs 10x, including twice in the chapter heading. ^{It's} ~~It's~~ the story of how she, as a barren woman became the mother of Samuel. More than half of all the "Hannah" occurrences in the OT occur on p. 382 "Anna".
