On 11/11, I tallied the ASCII sum of my ^{proposed} ^{motto} Sterling Daily news service to see if it has good resonance in Alphabetics (AB). It does.

OT def. H2568 means "weasel"—which is hardly complimentary—until you consider it as ^{an} antonym, at which point it comes sharply into focus. The Miriam Webster Collegiate Thesaurus (MWCT) on our tablet defines it, "1: v to avoid a definite answer or position [I take strong stances, trusting my intuition and life wisdom in providing a forest-view perspective on important matters]; [ant] syn. : equivocate, fudge, hedge, pussy foot, tergiversate, waffle." It defines "tergiversation: evasion of straightforward action or clear-cut statement; equivocation, desertion of a cause, position, party, or faith." Continuing the weasel def., we have "3: v [weasel (out of) to get or keep away from (as a responsibility) through cleverness or trickery." These are strong antonyms of integrity and wisdom.
