That's right, according to Strong's Exhaustive Concordance of the Bible © 2007 (Str.'07; ISBN 978-1-59856-378-8) by Hendrickson Publishers, Inc., the same that has been publishing this monumental volume nearly from the beginning; Israel means, "He will rule as God." Israel is the word which we want to be named/called after. (2 Ne. 30:2; see footnotes for Biblical counterparts.) The suffix, "el," of course, means "God," and the other root Str.'07 cites is "H8280 n<sup>7</sup>W šārō; to prevail;—have power, have power as a prince." (See my 8/20 editorial, "We're All Called to Be Immanuel.") This is compatible with the "heirs of God, and joint heirs with Christ" notion in Rom. 8:17. It's also consistent with Isa. 4:18<sup>23</sup> that summarizes what we<sup>that humanity</sup> are to know in the future (e.g. now) from the scriptures is "that ye are gods"—if we will.

In contrast, I can relate to the verse following that, because this is how I've been received/perceived: "24 Behold, ye are of nothing, and of your work of nought: an abomination is he that chooseth you." (Compare also Isa. 49:4,7; 53:2,3; 66:5; Ps. 18:22. 1 Ne. 21:21 re-

lates this motif generally to the House of Israel. All of the joint heirs are going to be able to relate to this to at least some extent, also having been marginalized/cast aside.)

The verse after Isa. 41:24 elaborated in the previous paragraph is the subject of my 11/7 editorial, "Kari Lake Depicted in Isa. 41:25."

In a 12/25 letter to Kari, still being composed, I came up with (by inspiration) the following summary statement, "God became man, so man can become God."

D&C 88:107 is also relevant here: "...The saints shall be filled with his glory, and receive their inheritance, and be made equal with him."
