Luke 10

(Jack?) Welch's Variation on Parable of Good Samaritan: Applies to a macrocosm/<sup>national/civilization</sup> prophetic<sup>^</sup> level.

Luke 10: man (Adam, all) came from Jerusalem (holy city/heaven), went down to Jericho (mortality), fell (Fall, opposition) among thieves; stripped of raiment (priesthood robes, Church Fellowship, identity/reputation); wounded him (spiritual identity, sin, addiction); priest & Levite walked by [Church leaders in unrighteous dominion apostasy, sidesteer<sup>e.g.</sup> the patriot stalwarts among them (1 Ne. 21:1; Jer. 23:1-2; Ezk. 34:1-10...)] ; Samaritan attends [Jer. 23:3-6; 34; Ezk. 34:11-16, 23, 24...]; half-dead [e.g. suicidal, dark/depressed]; bound up <sup>wounds</sup> words w/ wine & oil [annointed "Christ"; power of "joint heirs" appeal to motivate to all-in, synced]; takes to inn [e.g. Church Fellowship]; "go and do likewise" [Jer.
