

# AB on LGBTQ+ Pronoun Craziness

- hdg's abbr. Headquarters. [Historically, predominantly; corporation, political, religious, organization leadership has come mostly from males.]

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- H-bomb Hydrogen bomb [Attacking a country's moral foundation is more destructive than nuclear weapons when it comes to the country's viability.]
- \* • he A male person or animal.
- he-man Slang A man marked by strength; a muscular man. [Men, genetically, are stronger, faster than women. Women likewise have advantages, generally, over men, e.g. more nurturing, intuitive.]
- head [ditto hogos. See 1 Cor. 11:3 (& Eph. 5:23) "the head of the woman is the man"]

- sharp-tongued To have bitter or harsh speech [this topic tends to bring out the worst in people, including on both sides of the issue.]
- shatter To burst suddenly into pieces. [Crushing the last vestiges of morality]
- shave(r) [It's extremely rare that a tranny is good looking and actually looks like a lady (or man). Wrong look.]
- shawl [Trannies seem to think that wearing the clothes is a big part of the gig.]
- \* • she A female previously indicated by name; a third person singular pronoun.
- shear To form, cut, or remove the... hair with a sharp instrument; to clip [Hair length, like apparel, is another stereotypical way they "identify" as the opposite sex.]
- sheath A cover or case for the blade [Female plumbing, including the uterus - can't be faked by a tranny, or hormonally induced, or surgically added. A wom-

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an is born with all the eggs she'll ever produce — can't be added later. The womb is in the etymology of "woman."

- hill-top [ditto "head"]
- hilt The handle of a dagger or sword [Combined with "sheath," think chalice & blade. Male plumbing. Can't be completely recreated on a female to function as one who is born male.]
- \* • him The objective case of the pronoun he.
- Himalayas [highest mountain range, relates to male anatomy]
- \* • himself
- hind Located at or toward the rear part [Homo-sexual males, including trannies, lacking the female anatomy, often engage in anal sex.]
- hinder To interfere with [while a tranny might check some of the superficial boxes, there are hundreds of subtle attributes that only genuine genetics can provide.]

- thesaurus [These insights on transgenders as embedded in the alphabetical sequence of words — the wisdom of the ages]
- these The plural of this
- thesis A formal argument or idea [Since ~1987, in my writing, I've been using "they" as a singular, non-gender pronoun, so I don't have to say "he or she". I've done this in protest that English doesn't have an official non-gender, singular word. I've noticed in

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recent times that this is going mainstream. I'll probably continue this, even though it's now going "woke," just as I'll continue my support of being vegan, an environmentalist, even though some conservatives decry such as "woke." True principles should stand independent of party.]

- thigh [thickness & ratio is a genetic manifestation of gender]
- thin [males' thighs are proportionately thinner than females']
- thing [This is something that is almost impossible to change surgically.] [thigh thin thing]

- gutsy Slang Courageous [Relates to the male role of being a protector]
- guttate Spotted, discolored by drops or droplike spots [would be a "tell" from a woman (due to menstruation) posing as a man]
- gutter [low morals of trannies]
- guttersnipe A person of the lowest class or morals [ditto]
- gutteral Pertaining to the throat [The male adult voice is generally deeper/lower than females. A tranny's voice is one of the easier tells of reality.]

\* • guy Slang A man; a fellow

- guzzle To drink greedily, continually or to excess [is more common among guys]

- gym [is usually an easy tell of gender, including shape, speed, strength, gracefulness (♀)]

- gynandromorph An abnormal individual ex-

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hibiting physical features characteristic of both sexes. [Such (rare) individuals have a legitimate claim to decisions & discernment about gender, and utilizing hormonal/surgical remedies.]

- **gynandry** Hermaphroditism; the condition in an animal or plant where both male and female reproductive organs exist. [ditto]
- **gynecoid** Having female characteristics; being typical of a woman. [definitive]
- **gynecology** The branch of medicine dealing with the female reproductive organs, female diseases, and female organs. [ditto]
- **gyp** Informal To swindle, cheat, or defraud. n. A Fraud [e.g. Someone who professes to be a man or a woman when they are not.]
- **gyrate** [twisting the truth]

- **gaity** [variant of "gay"]
- **gain** [trannies see advantage in identifying as the opposite sex, but often later realize they've made a big mistake.]
- **gainsay** To deny; to contradict; dispute [They go against who they really are — "really are" referring to once they heal (e.g. via therapy, spirituality) the emotional dysfunction that created the confusion. It's fraud.]
- **gait** A way or manner of moving on foot [is strongly governed by biology: muscles & bone & tendon arrangement; and is quite different, generally, between males and females. It (gait) is another common tell of a tranny — that they're not really what they're posing to be.]

- gala A festive celebration; party [Females, more than males, tend to be drawn to organizing, set-up, inviting, and attending galas.]
- galactic [Among the many other planets like ours around the universe, the male/female differences are likely to be quite uniform.]

While all the above pronoun vicinity def.s tie in well to the transgender issue, the "guy" instance including essentially spelling it out, the vicinity def.s around "her" don't seem to have that tie. To the contrary, the def.s immediately around "her" seem relevant to my HMITF paradigm, which is fitting, given how important she is to evolving the s.c., which is the primary objective of the AB code overall.
