

Malaysian Flight 370 Disappearance in Alphabets

Page 370 of Str.'07 ~~#~~ is filled with the entry, "Fore," perhaps relating to the infrared footage that makes this viewable.

P. 370 of WDT opens with the text, "(gust...) wind or air [plane]; a sudden outburst [sudden flash / disappearance]."
