Boulder Fire: "Upon My House Shall it Begin"

The "Marshall Fire" in Boulder county, Colorado on Dec. 30th which engulfed 991 homes fanned by category 3 hurricane force gusts, captured international attention. I paid special attention because it occurred near where I grew up - so many fond memories.

On Jan. 5, my dad told me that the fire took out our home we built there in 1967-8, on 7225 Empire Dr. (They moved from there to Fountain Green, UT in 1992 to prepare for end-times events, selling the Boulder home for half a million dollars to build a new solar home. See AllasTIME.com/SolarHome/)

The Boulder home was situated at the edge of a huge (many square miles) field. It could have been the first home consumed by the incoming flames. I don't yet have the information about the progress of the fire.

I heard on the news that, on the day prior, a shed in Marshall ^{10-20 miles} to the west, had a fire, which apparently was not fully doused. I saw ^(12/30) ~~video~~ on TV of ^{the} ~~it~~ fully engulfed flames, billowing horizontally to the right, with no blackened/burned grass to the left of it (pointing to this as the 12/30 disaster origin). destroyed, damaged in Marshall Fire." (I've not seen it.)

A scripture verse came to mind after I got off the phone with my dad & mom: (non-r.c.)

"24 Behold, vengeance cometh speedily upon the inhabitants of the earth, a day of wrath, a day of burning, a day of desolation, of weeping, of mourning, and of lamentation; and as a whirlwind it shall come upon all the face of the earth, saith the Lord.

25 And upon my house shall it begin, and from my house shall it go forth, saith the Lord;

26 First among those among you, saith the Lord, who have professed to know my name and have not known me [Ps. 69:8], and have blasphemed against me in the midst of my house, saith the Lord." (D&C 112; see also 1 Pet. 4:17, 18.)

I don't cite this to imply that we're now on an intractable path to rock bottom. But I do see the Boulder Fire ^(burning my growing up-home) as a civilization ^{as a civilization} could be on the precipice of falling off the cliff to hit rock bottom — if we don't evoke the r.c. My book, None to One: Evoking the Repentance Clause of Prophecy, explains (A) how we can do this, and (B) that it is our preferred destiny if we will accept it. We can go straight to the kingdoms of heaven on earth, if we will.
