"Talent hits a target no one else can hit. Genius hits a target no one else can see."

- Arthur Schopenhauer

This quote contrasts two levels of exceptional ability: talent and genius. Talent, according to him, is the ability to achieve what others cannot^[as well], to hit a target that's visible but difficult to reach. It's about skill, precision, and the mastery of a craft to a degree that sets one apart from the ~~merger~~ majority. Talented individuals excel within the boundaries of what is known and recognized.
