He said that when he was a missionary, he put a lot of thought into what it might have been like to be a young parent at the time the 3 Ne. 124-22 controversy, coming-to-a-head.

If the sign didn't happen that night, the believers would be put to death. The day of Jesus' birth in the old world was paired with this brush with death for the believers in the new world.

Yesterday morning, in preparation for our class, Colby spent time ~~passing~~ assigning AI (ChatGPT?) the task of creating a historical fiction account of this event. ~~to~~ He tweaked it with follow-up prompts/info/adjustments, based on his having thought heavily on this situation.

Many of us were brought to tears as he read the account / fictional story, based on this scriptural event.

Afterward, I asked if it was somewhere online so I could link to it. He didn't seem to want to post it. After class, I asked if I could post it to my site. I'd include notice that he is not aware of the content of my site, and that this permission to post doesn't imply any endorsement. He handed me the piece, which he had read to us all.

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I should mention that in class, ~~I~~ after he said something to the effect that perhaps such an event could be yet in our future, I read Zech. 14:4-9 to show that this is indeed prophesied. I later added that these destructions ~~could~~ will be turned away if there is sufficient repentance of the people (e.g. 3 Ne. 16:13-15) and that there are some 30⁺ prophecies that depict this optional path that is a much higher path, going straight to the kingdom of heaven on earth without hitting rock bottom first.
