Today marks a week since I arrived here in the new prison in Salt Lake City, from Draper, and we finally found out what our mailing address is: P.O. Box 165300; SLC, UT 84116. We knew a couple of days ago that the physical address is 1480 N. 8000 W. I've been inquiring daily of the officers, who didn't know yet what the address is — illustrating the disbelivlement that has been characteristic of the move-transition (which has spurred me to start writing some editorials to bring these things to light).

This afternoon, I looked up our address numbers in AB and found quite a few points of resonance.

The most obvious set is the digits surrounding the last four digits of the zip code 84116 in the OT.

Bible is super resonant to "Heavenly Father"

as I present it in my book, including:

- The wording, "Ye see how large a letter I have written unto you with mine own hands..in the flesh" (Gal. 6:11,12)
- Verbatim string tie, in Eph. 1:2,3 "the God and Father... in heavenly places..."
- My "all in" theme (prerequisite to becoming ChoffB) is reflected in Gal. 6:9 "let us not be weary in well doing."
- The central AF13 filter of the ChoffB gifts of the Spirit that I talk about, especially governing use of the II, tp, and tk; is touched on by the Gal. 6:10 "As we have opportunity, let us do good unto all men..." Compare that to the AF13 string "We believe in...doing good to all men"
- The 2 Chor. 7:14 Pentecostal Prayer Event bringing about the Isa. 66:8 mighty change globally, is touched on in Gal. 6:15 string, "a new creature".
- The page opening verse, Gal. 6:6 ties to Eth. 4, which mentions "the Father" 7x, "greater things" 5x (my website), where Eth. 4:10 says "because of my Spirit he shall know that these things are true [compare Moro. 10:5]; For it persuadeth men to do good" — which is true of my book! Compare that to Gal. 6:6, "Let him that is taught in the word [ChoffB candidates] communicate unto him [e.g. me] that teacheth in all good things" The ~~it~~ makes that possible, effective, and efficient. Furthermore, the antecedent of "him"

becomes the ChFFB as they come in.

In the context of my being at the prison at this address, 1480 N., I see that the last verse of p. 1480 of the Bible, Eph. 1:4, ties in.

"4 According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world [we plan our life path before we're born. I believe I wrote prison into my plan], that [thanks to Jesus making repentance possible] we should be holy and without blame [innocent] before him in love;" [meaning of David].

The 8000th street number also ties in very well to my mission. Consider these OT def.s in vicinity: Def. H7999 [notice the upside-down 666 in this antonym of 666 in the number 7999] is the word translated "recompence" in Isa. 66:6; in the midst of the Isa. 66:4-8 crucial prophecy about evoking the r.c.i. "...a voice of the Lord that rendereth recompence to his enemies." Def. H7999 turns that seemingly confrontational situation into a peaceful encounter. Also along the lines of that turning a dicey situation into a peaceful one; I'm presently temporarily (for lack of available suitable housing) housed in a mixture of general population and Max inmates. I've found that a mixture of confidence and cordiality holds confrontation at bay. Granted, it seems the staff has purposely selected the more tame of the Max prisoners to be housed here! Here are the VTCARTY def.s:

• H7999 to be safe (in mind, body, or estate) [keep].
Keeping inmates safe is a cardinal responsibility, legally, of prisons, of which they often are derelict. True safety is a function of divine protection. Ask Daniel in the lion's den. I feel safe/protected.] ; to be (make) completed [accomplishing what I came here to earth to do]; to be friendly [I am]; to reciprocate [Treat people with respect, and it tends to bring the best out of them.] :- make amends [reconciliation], make good [Gal. 6:6 (p. 1480); Eth. 4:10], finish [bring my vision to fulfillment], make peace [via principles of goodness, including repentance and trust in God], be at peace [a fruit of the Spirit (Gal. 5:22 - p. 1479, prior to 1480)], peaceable [shlolah], that is perfect [Matt. 5:9 (would be better translated "complete")], perform [walk your talk], prosper [success in manifesting vision into reality], recompence [Isa. 66:6], restore [Acts 3:21 "restitution of all things"], reward [♀, rec., ChoffB, SV...]. . .

• H8001 sel'em; prosperity : - peace

• H8002 regnital, i.e. a (voluntary) sacrifice in thanks : - peace offering [my voluntary confession is what resulted in my incarceration]

• H8003 תְּקַוֵּם sal'em [Jerusalem]; complete; esp. friendly : - full, just, make ready, peaceable, perfect(ed), guest, whole [ditto H7999]

In summary, some of the highlight words in A.B. refer to the numbers of our

person address include "prison, plot, address;" and the ASCII sum of "Heavenly Father".
