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Remedies for Omicron — “(Oh)micron” not  
“(Ah)micron”

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### omicron

The new COVID variant has introduced a Greek letter name into mainstream vernacular that hitherto was only seen written out, not spoken, for the most part — by anyone. It has created a humorous phenomenon of a wide range of pronunciations in the media, both by hosts and guests, including M.D.s Professors.

Part of the problem to this ~~lack of consistency~~<sup>tend to</sup> is that Webster's gives two pronunciations: “omicron (äm'ikrən', öm'-) [ə-father; i-if]. You'll sometimes hear the same person pronounce it both ways within a couple of minutes, insecure in how to say it.

I submit that the most correct pronunciation is: “(Oh)micron” because (A) there is a strong correlation between the Greek and English alphabets, both in sequence of letters and pronunciation, not to mention how replete Greek words and derivatives are found in the English language; and (B) the first letter in an alphabet letter name corresponds to its pronunciation: alpha, beta, etc.; so the first portion of omicron should be pronounced “oh,” following kappa, lambda, mu, nu; prior to pi ( $\pi$ ) — one of the most familiar Greek letters. (Yes, omicron is immediately preceded by xi ( $\xi$ ).) In the sequence of variant names, nu and xi were skipped because “nu” is too easy to confuse with “new,” creating a “who's

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on first<sup>2</sup> (short) type of mixup; and calling it the "Xi variant" would be akin to calling COVID the "China virus" — a political taboo for the propagandists.

It turns out there is a significant Alpha-beta relationship, unintended (by me) but divine providence!

Two days ago, at the top of p. 642 of my media notes (I'm usually more slovenly), I usually write in clear writing, blue ink, the name underlined <sup>these</sup> omicron and its pronunciations; and that page ended up having quite a few notes about the variant.

Today, I noticed that the page number is 642, which is hugely significant in this context. 642 is the ASCII sum of "corona", which I looked up on March 13, 2020. On page 642 of Strong's 1897 (ISBN 978-1-59856-378-8) is the page heading (opening & closing entries) "Leffest-Leprosy" — a play on words and parallel of feared illnesses. That's certainly relevant. Page 642 of the Bible appendix of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, © 2013 copyright, lists the Bible Dictionary and includes the relevant entries: "Fear; Fear" — reflecting Congressman Ron Emanuel's charge: "Never let a good crisis go to waste." Milk it for all you can, but promote things people wouldn't otherwise accept. Fear shuts down rational thinking, both of individuals as well as of nations.

New Testament def. 6 [Greek] 642 — the six-hundred-forty-second def. alphabetically, according to James Strong (1822-1894), whose numbering is standard in Bible lexicons — means, "to...separate (from intercourse)" — social distancing. These are likewise, for this "omicron (äm'ikrǟn; öm'-)

Yes, COVID can be terrible and deadly. But if you employ remedial measures, its severity can be profoundly diminished.
