

Illegal Immigration - As a Lion Among the Beasts of the Forest

Since I was a teen, I've seen Micah 5:8 referring to a future treading down of the Gentiles (esp. United States as exemplars of the Western World) by the remnant of Jacob as including our being overrun by Latin Americans from the south. That view has grown stronger through the years, especially since Biden reversed Pres. Trump's effective border protection policies, leading to the invasion by illegal immigrants. This breach of national security not just an impeachable offense, but it easily rises to the level of treason.

It turns out there are scriptural sources that counter the fatalistic stance. Generally-speaking, all the cataclysmic end-times prophecies assume an "IF you don't repent, then..." preface. The corollary to this is, "IF you repent, then these eventualities will be turned away." The most well-known verse articulation of that is 2 Chron. 7:14, "IF my people... shall... turn from their wicked ways; then will I... forgive their sin, and will heal their land."

Even more specifically, 3 Ne. 16:13-15 and 21:12-14... From the Book of Mormon cite that Micah 5:8 prophecy and add (A) a repentance escape clause, and (B) "saith the Father" as the one offering that alternative to the fatalistic crash path. Consistent with the New Testament adoption of Gentiles into the house of Israel (remember, "Israel" means "He will rule as God" - Strong's [See my 8/20 editorial, "We're All Called to Be Immanuel"]), the 3 Ne. 16:13, 14 preface to the Micah 5:8 citation says,

"13 But IF the Gentiles will repent and return unto me, saith the Father, behold they shall be numbered among my people, O house of Israel. F

14 And I will not suffer my people, who are of the house of Israel, to go through among them,

and tread them down, saith the Father.

15 But if they will not turn unto me, and hearken unto my [Father's] voice, I will suffer them, yea, I will suffer my people, O house of Issaël, that they shall go through among them, and shall tread them down, and they [Gentiles] shall be as salt that hath lost its savor, which is therefore good for nothing but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of my people, O house of Issaël."

Now that Biden has flown and bussed so many illegals throughout the United States, giving them free phones, meals, and all kinds of perks, pushing for more all the time (a form of economic "treading down," portending the violence to come—if we don't repent)—including pushing to be able to vote in New York, to set the trend for the rest of the country; in light of the Micah 5:28 prophecy, concepts like "sleepers cells" and "marxist candidate" come to mind.

All that is needed is a flip of a switch, e.g. the ^{event,} right disruptive, and these sleepers become lions in our midst. I suggest we repent to avert this.
