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555; Tp in Alphabetics

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On the heels of writing my piece, "Start Giving Global Conspirators Justice Via Tp to Karma Planets," this morning, I wanted to look up some ASCII sums relating to tp in that context. The ASCII sum of "Tp'ing to Justice" = 1571. In looking up p. 553 (ASCII sum of "Tp'ing") WOT, I noticed p. 555 — a great number, where I've long associated 5 generally with ♀ / HMITF.

It turns out that ⁺p. 555 WOT has very strong relevance to my HMITF paradigm, mostly with antonyms, including the page headers: "nominal 555 none-the-less." It's not ~~just~~ nominal, it's super strong. It's not ^{none}"no to answer." She resolves that problem, It's not "less," it's the epitome of greater things. Here are some other highlights.

- nominate To select a candidate... [for HMITF]
- nomism Conduct based on moral or religious beliefs. [Living true]
- nomology The science of the formation of law; the science that deals directly with the laws of reason [There's a lot of reform needed, so this science will play a crucial role. "Out of Zion shall go forth the law!"]
- non - Prefix Not. [Both the OT & NT main def-s for "mother" (H517 & G3384) are preceded & followed by def-s

with the meanings of "not," conveying the "none to answer" general sentiment that must be overcome.]

- nonabrasive [in contrast to the "none to answer" abrasiveness that has been so typical]
- nonabsorbent [ant.: able to receive]; not rocky soil
- nonadhesive [ant.] ^{Not having <strikes> <show <strike through>} ... the quality to adhere
- nonacceptance [ant.]
- nonadministrative [ant.] ... pertaining to the executive...
- nonappearance The failure to appear [ant. of stepping up, all-in, synced up; ^{nearly} verbatim with NT def. "Gr 666 a being away :- absence"]
- nonbeliever [ant.] a person who does not believe in God [eg. HMIFIF]
- nonchalant [ant. all-in]
- noncollegiate ~~Not bett~~ [ant. Isa. 50:4 "God hath given me the tongue of the learned" - ^{quoted} vs on p. 69 <Ⓢ> BoFM]
- noncombatant [This one isn't ant an ant. The sic roll-out doesn't involve violence.] But I bet ♀ will be plenty spunky / feisty, stand^{ing} boldly against evil.]
- noncombustible Not easily ignitable [shiloh / tranquil]
- noncompos mentis [ant.] Mentally unbalanced; ~~not~~ <strike through> of sound mind.
- nonconductor [ant. leadership]
- nonconformist [non-dogmatism is a good thing] One who does not feel compelled to follow or accept tradition [not without scrutinizing]
- noncooperation [ant. "cooperation the combination

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of persons (e.g. ChofFB) for purposes of production, or distribution for their joint (heirs of Christ) benefit and success"]

- noncorrosive [non-toxic]
- nondelivery [ant.: bringing ^{forth} for the man child (Isa. 66:7) JST-Rev. 12:3, 12) = kingdom of heaven on earth]
- nondescript [^{bride}veiled] A person or something not easily classed or described.
- nondestructive ["H516 thou must not destroy"; "H517 mother"]
- nondistinctive [ant. "a peculiar people" will be epitomized by me & her.]
- none [to answer changed to "one" / HMITF]
- noneffective [ant.] ^{<stroke>}without the necessary power to cause or produce effect [Manifest this paradigm into reality]
- nonentity [ant. "I am"]
- nonessential [ant.] ^{<stroke>}not absolutely necessary

I'd rate that page a 9.5 in relevance to HMITF.

I rated p. 553, two pages prior, a 6 in relevance to "Tipping" = 553, with def-s "nigh Near in ... time, or space" [distance is irrelevant in to]; and "nimble Marked by quick, light movement." The def-s "ninety" and "nine" relate to the lost sheep, which are redeemed (or at least far more likely to) in the scenario I depicted in that piece.

p. 585 (From the lower-case "t" in "tipping")
 WDT I rated ~~slightly~~ slightly higher: 7 (I rated p. 553 a 6), with these relevant (nominally) def.s. "peacemeal Gradually [ant. the immediacy of tip]; pierce [tip does it go "through" the intermedia space between locations but goes directly to the destination]; piety [(A)^{tip} is a power of God, (B) made available to the joint heirs / ChofFB]; piggy-back [Though only ChofFB have the tip gift, their "cargo" can include humans (As long as the conveyance is AF13 compliant)]; pilgrim A person who travels to a sacred space [AF13], a wanderer [ant. tip entails purpose, per AF13]; pillow [people like Mike Lindell (My Pillow.com) who sponsors much of the RAV TV content will be among the early ones to become ChofFB]; pilot [tip is as simple as visualizing where you want to go via the IT, then you're there]; pimp [not allowed; ^{IT's} contrary to AF13]; pilfer [ditto].

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"Sound of Freedom" Hits \$100 Mil. During Screening at Trump's Resort

As a follow-up to my 7/19/23 ~~art~~ blog post, "Sound of Freedom's Success Evinces Society's Readiness to ^{Evolve} Evince R.C.", I'd like to point out some AB resonance with the fact that "Sound of Freedom" box office sales reached \$100 million

dollars the night (7/20) that Pres. Trump hosted ^{the} screening at his Bedminster (so?), NJ golf club facility / resort. Tim Ballard (basis of story) and Jim Caviezel (actor, played Jesus in the box office record holder "The Passion of Christ") sat on either side of him as he watched intently for the 2.5-hour movie.

The ASCII sum of "Trump" = 536. On p. 536 Str. 07 is the entry "Hundred", which calls to mind "100%" in context of Pres. Trump. Consistent with that, 536 is also the ASCII sum of "I'm in" including the quotation marks.

Another point of all-in related relevance is that the primary (~99%) OT def. translated "hundred" is H 3967, which has embed both 376 ("HMETF" ASCII) and 369 ("HFETF" ASCII), which epitomize "all in".

Therefore, I found the "Sound of Freedom" reaching \$100 million in sales on the night of its screening at Pres. Trump's resort to show / evince God's hand in all this: the movie's success; the key players in that movie calling Trump a modern "Moses"; Trump's future leadership role, which I lay out in None to One.
