News

- ThisWeek/ABC Biden digging in. 38 House, 4 Sen Dem call for him^{to step down}
- Tr.: "The Dem party is not the party of democracy. Really, they're the enemy of democracy" [Marxists deplore freedom]
- ^{Sen.} "Chuck Schummer has called for Biden to leave race"
- NYT: Pelosi urges open convention [not Harris] if Biden drops out. Many about to go public in coordinated manner (for ↑)
- Joe Manchin: "Govt. should be a partner [no, just protector], not provider." Re: Kamala, ~ "Race, gender should not be driver in selection."
- Speaker Mike Johnson: "We have two administrations with ^{two} records we've experienced. NATO allies deeply concerned about vulnerability globally from US weakness."
