

More AB Witnesses of Tudor Dixon's Resonance with the HMITF Role

This piece is a follow-up to my 11/26 blog article, "Tudor Dixon's Resonance with the HMITF Role," which requested as a prerequisite that you at least read the first ~200 pages of my book, None to One: Evoking the Repentance Clause of Prophecy, available from [my site](#).

Here are some highlights from that piece:

• Page 526 [“Tudor” ASCII sum] of WD1 includes the HMITF-relevant def.s “Messiah; messenger; metagalaxy; Meteoric” and the facing page includes these Tudor-specific/resonant def.s: “Michigan, microphone, meticulous.”

• “Tudor” inserts alphabetically on p.526 (“Tudor”)

T.G.'13, and includes the entries “Turn see also Repent [s.c.]”; Twain [join to one]; and these destruction motif entries, “Tumble; Tumult,” which are averted by evoking the s.c. They’re preceded by “Toy, Tried,” relating to Tudor’s meeting up with the challenge before us.

• Page 1605 [ASCII sum of “Tudor Dixon-Allan”] of the 2013

Bible extrapolates to p.11 T.G.'13 that includes these entries:

“Anointed One [Messianic]; Answer [resolving the ‘none to answer’ problem, per the None to One book title]; Anti-Christ [exorcising]; Averting [averting by evoking the s.c.]; Anxiety [anti-shuloh]; Apathy [anti-all-in, synced up].”

Last night, I realized/remembered that the Cover Page I made for N2O has the following at the

bottom of the page (the stereo design was done by my celly
in CUCF, Gunnison ~2017):

by Sterling D. Allan
(ASCII) 1506 = 1506

I remember wondering, at the time I wrote that (in 2021) on the cover, what thing of significance might come of that. Yes, 1506 resonates with me. For example,

NT def. Gr 1506 is nearly verbatim to a meaning Dan Brown (The Lost Symbol, or ^{or Angels and Demons} is it Da Vinci Code?) gives for sterling: "judged by sunlight, i.e. tested as genuine (fig.) — pure, sincere." "Pure" is a meaning dictionaries sometimes give for "sterling." "Sincere" is a Thesaurus synonym.

Now, I know that a slight transposition of this, 1605, is the ASCII sum of "Tudor Dixon-Allan". So, there on the cover of my book, tied to my name, is a coded tie to Tudor — the one who answers — hopefully; resolving the "none to answer" problem (Isa. 66:4; 65:12; 63:5; 50:2 (= 2 Ne. 7:2); 41:26, 28; 34:12; Ezk. 22:30, 31; Jer. 12:11; Rom. 3:10-12 — none of which are listed in the T-G- "None" entry — not flattering).

That's huge.

Also, last night, I looked up "Tudor" on my M-W-C tablet dictionary: "Tudor 1: adj. of or relating to the English royal house [p. 526 str. 07 "House"] that ruled from 1485-1603." 1485 is one removed from 1484 = "Heavenly Mother" ASCII. 1603 is two removed from 1605 = "Tudor Dixon-Allan". That's also very significant. Yes, it would be even better if the reign range was exactly 1484-1605, but God likes to stretch us at least a little. Vicinity counts for much in ASB.

In my previous piece on Tudor, I didn't mention what I found on p. 526 (Tudor) of Oxy, because I only rated it a 7. But I'd like to mention it now because it's ^{one third} predominantly filled with def.s starting with "like-", which is a primary word used for propagating good material in Social Media ; and a primary role of HMITF (once she accepts this role/invite) in launching the r.c., by making my hitherto suppressed writing available (via her promotion/endorsement) to mankind. In so doing, she unveils both me and herself to humanity, as well as the teaching (idea whose time has come) that "We're All Called to Be Immanuel" (8/20/22 Editorial). [Like]

Here are some highlight def.s from p. 526 Oxy. It opens with "lightning" - the yin/yang partner of "thunder". My Native American adopted name is "SilverThunder".

- lights [light that shines in darkness (Isa. 9:2; 42:6 - from prison; 60:1,3)]
- likable / likeable pleasant, easy to like [Tudor]
- like¹ things of the same kind [§]
- like² 1. find pleasant or satisfactory ; 2. wish for, want
- like-minded having similar tastes or opinions
- liker [is a major tool of AB; consistent with 1 Ne. 19:23, 24 admonition to like Isaiah (the scriptures) to ourselves]
- likeness 1. resemblance 2. outward appearance humans are made in God's likeness [Philip 2:25,6 "Let this mind be in you (all of us), which was also in Christ Jesus : who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God"] - p. 1489 (Lansing zip 48909)]
- liking
- lit [m-w-c "the attractive quality of speech or music that rises and falls in a pleasing pattern" → Tudor's gift of public address, feeling natural, sincere, pleasant, friendly]

- lily a plant with large trumpet-shaped flowers... [beautiful voice for proclaiming truth and common sense]
- lily-livered cowardly [ant. courageous]
- lily-white 1. pure white 2 totally innocent or pure [good integrity]
- lamb [Branch; Jer. 33:15,16 "the Branch of righteousness... and this is the name wherewith she shall be called, The Lord our righteousness"]
- limber v. warm up in preparation for exercise or activity [Tudor's life up until now, in prep. for this role] adj. supple, flexible [not dogmatic; open to considering new ways of seeing things, embracing what's good]
- limbo¹ 1 (in some Christian beliefs) [relates, synchronistically, to my article, "ChoffB to Help Rule Universe - Tomorrow's World" that I wrote yesterday, mentioning my strong disagreement with Tw's stance of there being no activity for a person's spirit between death and resurrection. I see such synchronicities /application of this specificity (relating to something unusual /specific that happened to be very significant yesterday, while still mulling what I've found in AB about Tudor)]
2 an uncertain period of waiting [(A) me, waiting for Tudor's response or joining me via tp for our joint theophany with Jesus; (B) Tudor weighing all of this and its ramifications]

Here are some I omitted above:

- lightweight [according to a website Mary looked up for me, Tudor is 5'5" (I'm 5'9", 160lb.)] 2 informal a person of little importance political lightweight [ant. MI Gov. candidate, whose win was stolen]
- light year [distance becomes irrelevant once we HMITF steps forward, becoming with me the first ChoffB, who all will have the gift of the Spirit of tp - physically, via this metaphysical gift]
- likelihood [of Tudor embracing the HMITF role, to launch r-c. /new world]
- likely 1. probable 2. promising [ditto]

- lilac [blossoms around Mother's Day each year (in Boulder, CO; our neighbors had a ~200' row of lilacs as a natural/beautiful border between our properties), relevant to HMITF; as is Tudor's May 5 birthday (if that web page Mary looked up is correct), within a few days of Mother's Day]

- Lilliputian adj. very small [5'5"] or unimportant [ant.]

Speaking of juxtapositioned vicinity, the portion of my tattered Ox4 dictionary where p. 526 occurs ~~is~~ is in a segment (loose) that goes from p. 519-588. #519 is two away from "H517 mother," and the next segment that's been sitting open on the page on the table where I'm sitting, ~~is~~ is displaying p. 589 that includes these def.s: "moth-eaten shabby or very worn [Ox4, so this page lays open]; mother; ... Mother's Day" is the last def. in the first column before a portion (bottom, right 1/3) of the page that is torn off/missing. Considering God's ability to orchestrate such things — that to most people would be considered completely random and meaningless — something I had no part of creating (I received the book — thrown in my cell in Dog Block through my cuff port, after someone stole my M-W dict. in this condition, which I've maintained carefully) — I see this arrangement to highlight, synchronistically — outside of my conscious intention — what I just wrote about lilac and Mother's Day and Tudor's b-day — on the page corresponding to the ASCII sum of her name. (518)

Meanwhile, the left-side open page includes the def. "left" — very literal in this case. "lefty; leftism; left wing; leftie" are all strong antonyms here, of you. Synchronistically, the def.s on this page are almost an exact overlap of the def.s on p. 489

WDT that I looked up a couple of days ago for possible relevance to Tudor's Lansing, MI zip code, 48909. I rated it a 7 as well. Some of the relevant def.s from p.-489 WDT include: "lectern ~~rep.~~ [campaigning, speaking]; lecture; leer [ant. kind disposition]; legacy; legal ^{immediately} [just as I wrote that, Buck Sexton said "legal"; ~11:17 am 11/28? - synchronicity]; legato Music smooth and flowing with successive notes connected [Shiloh personality]; legend [already]; legendary [m-w-c "legend (the stuff of legend) someone or something that is very famous or memorable". On KQRS, a regularly-playing ad talks about / promotes an upcoming ^{Invest Wealth} summit with "Tudor Dixon, Tucker Carlson, Buck Sexton" in FL; so I hear ^{her} name on the radio at several times a day as I've been working on these write-ups of what I'm finding in AB about ^{her} name. (Usually, I'm listening / watching TV: 23-3 NTD Epoch Times; 16-6 SCAMPS; 8-6 Story; 30-1 CW. Usually I only catch ^{only} about 30 min of KQRS / week, usually Beck on Sunday [?], "best of the week".)

Given these page synchronies, and my further seeing things upon looking more carefully, I'm changing my rating of p.-526 O&4 to a ^{9.5} _{O&4}, and p.-489 WDT to an 8.5.

Yesterday morning, I called my dad to have him ask my mom what time of day I was born. Her off-the-top-of-her-head recollection was same as mine - early in the morning, e.g. around 4am. I asked him to have her look it up in her well-organized records (or stuff like this).

Then, later this morning, as I was writing the above about the tattered O&4, I stopped to call my dad to get the

answer about when I was born, if my mom was able to find it. When the call went through, the first thing he said was 9225 pm; explaining that mom looked it up and found it in her records. It was a brief call.

Then it dawned on me how significant and relevant that number is, encoding my full name, Sterling David Allan. (Sterling is 925 parts silver, 75 parts copper; my dad, David Allan, was born 9/25.) Now, it turns out I was born at 9225 pm. I called him back and recited what I just noted, then quoted from p. 925 of the Bible: "therefore my people shall know my name; therefore they shall know in that day, that I am he that doth speak; behold, it is I." I then humorously said, "Coincidink" (coincidence) - they keep piling up ^{"mountain"}.

9:25 pm would be a great time for the joint (with Tudor) theophany to take place ~~as~~ Stand-up count is done by then, fellow inmates are settling down for the night. I could go to the toilet stall (has space ~1.5' under where people can see, and is about 4' high, giving plenty of privacy, while allowing one to see the space is occupied via bending down to look for feet), and no one would notice me tipping away / disappearing. And my bedding turned over for sleep, ~~as~~ unoccupied would not alarm any officers as they walk by around the top of each hour through the night. I could come back to get some rest, as needed. I can come and go (tiping) as needed via the toilet stall or shower stall for the next four days (1201-1204 study of previous piece).

to be here for counts... I may want to skip a count, just to put them on notice that I'll soon be permanently gone except for an occasional visit.

Or, if Tudor is joining me for these (925 AB points strongly to that) and has a place for me to stay, I could make my prison exodus sooner than later. One of my early visits, with Tudor, will be to Roger Powell, the warden who I met with (as Deputy Warden 7/10/2018) for 1:15 hours. We'll let him know the r.c. (I told him about) is underway, and he need not worry about me - I've been vindicated by Jesus.

As mentioned above, the AB resonance for this theophany occurring at 9:25 pm is super strong.

[theophany with Jesus appearing to HMITF & HFITF together]

I also rated this page a 9.5.

Page 925 WDT

Page 925 WDT overlays the (A) the last half of p. 228 [my offender # 228033] T-6:13 and (B) the middle-ish portion of p. 550 [the my CUCF, Grunison PO Box #] Str. 07, both of which start with “integrity”—a synonym of sterling. They both are where “Interface” ^{about} inserts alphabetically—as in Infinite Interface (II) which I came up with and wrote a 180-page business plan while in CUCF 2016-18. Those pages parallel / apply well to what I did. Thus synchrony of these three page numbers that tie strongly to me, all of which relate also to the II, are strongly resonant with the notion of the II being activated as part of this several-day theophany.

The last ^{four} three def.s on p. 925 WDT tie strongly to the notion of HMITF [Tudor] being present at the theophany, and her commitment to me and thus paradigm having been solidified.

- invisible [veiled in the flesh] (SYN) indistinguishable [from other extraordinary heroes], unseen [for who she really is], imperceptible [“H517 mother”; “Gr517 invisible”]
- invite (SYN.) bid, ask, encourage, urge [my recent packet to Tudor mailed 11/26, setting forth evidence about her being HMITF]
- inviting (SYN) appealing, alluring, attractive [Tudor is gorgeous]
- involuntary < p. 926 > (ANT.) voluntary, willful [stepping forward]

The two def.s prior to that depict her scrutinizing this

proposal.

- investigate (SYN.) look, probe, scrutinize, ferret, examine, seek [and ye shall find — D&C 93:1, 1 Ne 11:1], explore, search, question, inspect, study.
- investigation (SYN.) exploration, interrogation, quest, question, scrutiny, inquiry, query, examination, study, research [Relates mostly to my process of coming to these conclusions to present for Tudor's consideration.]

The def. before this relates to the unorthodox nature of my paradigm in how to set right-side-up what is up-side-down across all sectors of society. It relates to the setting-in-order key aspect of this ministry as prophesied e.g. in Ezk 21:25-27; D&C 85:7,8; Jer 23; Ezh 34; D&C 64:35-40.

"27 I will overturn, overturn, overturn [completely], it: and it shall be no more [Satan exiled] the key Marxist conspirators tried to parallel planet that collapsed...], until [actually, in conjunction with] he [she] come whose right it is [Shiloh]; and I will give it him [her]."

That appears on p. 1055 of the Bible, the ASCII sum of "typ'd letter", which will be required for Tudor to get this in time. The opening verse of that page says, "Say, A sword, a sword..." tying to p. 1130 [my 11/30 b-day, when I see this theophany happening at 9:25 pm] of Str. '07 where that is the last entry on the page, which begins with "Sweet" — sweet-sword, where the pen is mightier than the sword to turn away destruction by evading the sc. "to sword" appears 11x on this page with Ezh 21:25-27 closing the page.

Now, with all that in mind, consider this def prior to

the "investigate, investigation" set.

- invert (SYN.) upset, turn about, transpose, countermind, revoke, reverse, overturn. [The art. ties to the effect of Tudor stepping forward:] (ANT.) stabilize, endorse. [In my scenario these two things are integrally tied. HAITF's endorsement / promotion of my work is what enables the r.c. to be evoked, to stabilize a world crashing around us.]

It's what's implied in the book name None to One [endorse] - Evoking the Repentance Clause of Prophecy.]

The three def.s before that depict my envisioneering this scenario / paradigm I've been unfolding in earnest, grace for grace (D&C 93:12, 20) in earnest since Aug 11, 2014.

- invent (SYN.) devise, contrive, design, concoct, frame, conceive [born 9/25, 11/30], contrive, create, originate
- inventive (SYN.) fanciful, imaginative, visionary, clever, creative (ANT.) unromantic, dull, prosaic [I'm certainly not]
- inventiveness (SYN.) cunning, cleverness, ingenuity, aptitude (ANT.) ineptitude, clumsiness, dullness

"Invasion," in this context relates to how Tudor's peers, associates might perceive my approach to her, out of nowhere, suddenly, unexpected. Generally, it also relates to several global situations: (A) immigrant / migrant invasions, (B) Ukraine war; (C) Hamas attack & Israel's retaliation; (D) Taiwan pending; (E) S. Korea next, w/o kinetics; (F) U.S. is the ultimate target.

In contrast, I'm certain this is how God views my quest: "invaluable (SYN) priceless, precious, valuable."

The def. before that depicts my fulfillment of Isa 41:21

"Produce your cause, saith the Lord; bring forth your strong reasons..."

It presents the antonym of this: "- invalidate (SYN.) annul

[ant. counterslip for ultimate marriage], cancel [cancel], abolish

[cancel], revoke [cancel], abrogate; (ANT.) promote, restore

[former credibility; Isa. 57:18 "and will restore comforts to his

mourners"], sustain, establish [kingdom of heaven on earth],

continue [I have pursued this quest without letting up since

Aug. 11, 2014.]"

The "invade" variation of "invasion" I mentioned/
addressed above occurs just before "invaluable" as a suitable
antonym sentiment of the unsettling sentiment that Tudor's
peers/associates/family/friends are likely to express/feel.
What will enable her to embrace this "strange" work, not-
withstanding, is depicted on:

- intuition (SYN.) insight, acumen, perspicuity, discernment,
instinct, clairvoyance.

On the previous side of "intuition" are two more related def.s

also synonymous with "invade/invasion": "intrude"). And jux-

tapposed before that are these that relate to the "investigate/

investigation" set as part of the invitation:

- introduce (SYN.) acquaint, present, submit, offer, propose [mar-
riage, ultimate, the prophesied bride/brode/groom motif
that all marriages point to: the veiled bride unveiled]
- introduction (SYN.) preamble, prelude, beginning [launch of
the kingdom of heaven on earth], prologue, start, preface [in-
cluding the theophany]

Introduce/introduction also relates to coming into
the presence of Jesus, while we're incarnate, emerging from

our reel.

In contrast to the many other insults I've extended in this quest to find HMTF, this approaching Tudor seems more of this ilk:

- Intrinsic (SYN.) natural, inherent, inbred, congenital, inborn, native [e.g. actual]

Unlike the others I've approached who have mostly ignored, sometimes repelling, and in the case of Mary: declining while continuing to help as she can make time, as a fairly low priority; this def. before "intrinsic"

- Intricate intrigue (SYN.) design [SHV], plot [r.c. roll-out timeline], cabal [exposing], machination [ditto], strategem [detailing the particulars, logistics], scheme [ditto], attract [you love it], charm [includes romantic elements], interest [more than & many of the best-selling novels, combined], captivate [I got her! ☺]

Notwithstanding, if not especially because it's so:

- Intricate (SYN.) compound [tying many things together], perplexing [plenty of ironies / paradoxes], complex [^{Prov.} Ps. 25:2 "It is the glory of God to conceal a thing: but the honor of kings is to search out a matter."], involved [ties to the full spectrum of human endeavors and our place as destined leaders in the universe among planets like ours], complicated [more PhD theses will be written about this than anything else thus far].

Pushing / promoting / advocating / broaching this does not often go so well.

- intrepid (SYN.) brave, fearless, insolent, abrupt, rude [I don't mean to be, but am sometimes construed this way], pushy [Is

a reason given for my being dismissed from chapel/music access until Jan 1, 2024], adventurous, daring, courageous, prominent, striking [stand out], forward [assertive], imprudent ["unrealistic"].

"intoxicated" does not apply to me. I don't do drugs or alcohol. My musings are all from a clear mind.

In contrast to the receptiveness I anticipate from Tudor is

- intolerant (SYN.) Fanatical [dogmatic], narrow-minded, prejudiced, bigoted, illiberal, dogmatic, biased [are all traits that keep someone from accepting my material]

One of the tools I use quite regularly in my writing, letting the reader fill in the missing pieces with adequate setting of the context, is.

- . intimation (SYN.) reminder, implication, allusion, hint, situation. [But more often, I tend to =] (ANT.) declaration, statement, affirmation

The next two def-s, continuing in reverse alphabetical sequence, I see relating to our three-some theophany: Jesus, Father and Mother, who are one.

- intimacy (SYN.) fellowship, friendship, acquaintance [Tudor & I are at this early juncture], frankness, [like in Young Sheldon], familiarity, unreserved, liberty [to speak mind]
- . intimate (SYN.) chummy, confidential [when needed; most things will be for public consumption], friendly, loving, affectionate, close, familiarity, near, personal, private, secret [ditto confidential]

In Strong's p-550 and T-Gr.'13 p. 228, immediately before

the insertion place of "Interface" is the entry "intercession", which is a huge component of this advert. We don't have to hit rock bottom before repenting after grovelling under the reign of the beast.

By pre-emptively repenting sufficiently as a society, thanks to the power of the word of God it bring forth, and HMIF's endorsement opens to public acceptance and propagation; we can go straight to the kingdom of heaven on earth. The activation of the IT plays a major role in launching this higher path / option. HMIF puts her public reputation on the line by endorsing my paradigm. Until now, no one has been willing to do that, so my writings remain un-shared, unnoticed, except for a slow trickle of about one visitor every other day for about half a year. Hence the relevance of ^{this} these two intercession-related def.:

- **intervene** (SYN.) insert [oneself], intercede, inject, introduce [to others], interpose, mediate, ... [on behalf of humanity]

In the context of the theophany spanning several days, coming and going, e.g. for sleep, toilet, errands, tending to personal issues, consider "interval (SYN) pause, gap." Ditto "intervene (SYN.) suspend, delay, postpone, defer, adjourn, stay, discontinue (ANT.) prolong, persist, continue, maintain, proceed."

The opening word on the page, concluding the "interrogate" entry from the previous page, is "examine." While that's not the ideal theophany synonym, it is a relevant synonym.

Here, briefly, are some 9:25 pm 11/30 - relevant from p. 924 (the facing page) def.s: "insufficient (ANT.) ample, protracted, abundant, big, extended [in scope and duration]; insulation (SYN.) segregation, seclusion, isolation, solitude [on exceedingly high mountains (with Thor and Jesus)]; (ANT.) union, communion, association

fellowship, connection; insult (ANT.) compliment, homage,
 salutation, praise; integrated (SYN.) mingled, mixed,
 combined; intellect (SYN.) understanding [vision of all];
 intellectual; intelligence (SYN.) reason; sense, mind, ability,
 skill, aptitude [contribute to what can be seen]; intent (SYN.)
 plan, prepare, scheme, design, plot, deliberate [engineering];
 intense (SYN.) brilliant, bright animated, graphic, lucid,
 bright, expressive, vivid, deep, profound, concentrated [de-
