

Alphabetics Commentary on Artificial Intelligence

Yesterday, after finishing my post, "Israel-Hamas War" = 1473 (ASCII sum) Alphabetics Commentary", I launched into an AB probe on A.I. What I wasn't expecting was for this A.I. set to tie to the Israel-Hamas War study I'd just completed. But it does, very well, so I recommend that you read that one before reading this one.

That Israel doesn't live up to its "He shall rule as God" name meaning (43478, Str.07), but should, parallels that A.I. doesn't yet live up to its "skillful wisdom" ideal. I see there being two things that will profoundly facilitate A.I. achieving this ideal. One, would be to apply the AF-13 Filter (Articles of Faith 13, citing Philip 4:18; 1 Cor. 13:7), to which would contribute to giving A.I. a "conscience".

Another, would be the activation of the Infinite Interface (II) and favoring / favoring heavily II-based content, which is of divine origin. The first ASCII sum I tabulated yesterday was "A.I." = 230. Page 230 of WOT (ISBN 1-57755-017-X) has quite a few definitions

that relate to concerns I've ~~heard~~ voiced quite often about AI. Spilling from the previous page, the first def. on the page is "displace v. (p. 230) to take the place of; to discharge from an office; to cause a physical displacement of." People are afraid of becoming obsolete to computers that can outthink, outwork, and have access to ^{nearby} all information created by mankind. They don't yet realize that with the activation of the II in the coming days, those who become joint heirs of Christ ("all-in, synced up"), will not only have access to the totality of human knowledge, but we'll be able to access all AF-13 compatible information. It's the "Infinite Interface," as depicted, e.g. in 2 Ne. 30:16-18;

<11/4> Eth. 4:6-7, 13-15; D&C 121:26-33. The II content is conveyed directly to your mind, at the speed of thought, and is controlled by your thoughts. As soon as you ask a / think a question, there's the answer - the best available for you, drawing from the infinite database of the heavenly repository of all info, instantly. Because your question most likely is put in your mind by your intuitive, higher self, it knows what you're going to ask as soon as you start asking it. Hence Isa. 65:24, "before they call, I will answer; and while they are speaking, I will hear." The auto-complete ^{I guess} function of search boxes approximates this phenomenon, except this will be at the speed of thought.

When you're doing your God-calling, these tools will not make you obsolete. They'll be empowering: Both the IT and AI, (with the AFIB filter and accessing IT-derived content).

The next def. on p. 230 WDT is "display v. To put forth; to show off; to put in view." AI is famous for its ability to create visual content. The IT will be 3D and display what you imagine as soon as you imagine it (AFIB); and you can edit/modify it at the speed of thought. Perfect fidelity, able to view something from any angle or distance.

Here are more defs., in sequence, that also relate.

- displease v. To cause the disapproval or annoyance of. --

[Most everyone has concerns about AI, despite its obvious benefits. In contrast, the IT is something we all were in on the design of before we were born / incarnated (we also designed remedies for concerns about AI).]

- dispose v. To put in place [is already in play, rapidly advancing], to finally settle or come to terms [perhaps we will, once we (society) come to terms with ~~how~~ how my paradigm puts the needed checks on AI's power]. of To get rid of [is what some argue for, until they quickly realize others will keep developing it. I've ever heard people advocate for using the military to take out the AI server buildings.] ...

- disposition n. Prevailing mood... [has a wide range, depending on many factors]

- **dispossess** [fear of obsoleting /obliterating humans]
- **disproportion** [presently, the AI bias is strongly toward the left / woke end of the political — pro Marxist, anti-Judeo-Christian ~~and~~ morals]
- **disprove** v. Prove to be false or erroneous [AI is known for having ~~as~~ an inadequate discernment of even ethics, sometimes making stuff up and presenting it as fact. AI doesn't disclose when it's been told to create something that is not true, e.g. "deep fakes". The II will make truth vs. error clear and will be trustworthy.]
- **disputable** [dɪsˈtəbl̩]
- **disqualify** [AI's dishonesty^{and biases} should be a strong factor in weighing its value. These will be hugely diminished by implementing the remedies I've mentioned.]
- **disquiet** v. To take away the tranquility of; to trouble [e.g. use in lethal weaponry ; bias against value of humans ; possibility of it obsoleting and annihilating^{annihilating} humans ; Big Brother on steroids ; etc...]
- **disquisition** n. A formal inquiry into or discussion of a subject. [Several have been made and will yet be made]
- **disregard** v. To ignore ; to neglect ; to pay no attention ; to treat without proper attention [is human tendency — denial of the severity of a problem / threat, until it's too late]
- **disrelation** n. The lack of a fitting or suitable connection. [Humans have an intuitive connection to God, computers don't. That divine connection gives us access to^{the truth of} all things (Moro. 10:5). The II taps that.]

- **disrepair** n. The state of being in need of repair, usually due to neglect. [Computers are susceptible to e.g. EMP—would take it down in ~10 nanoseconds—permanently (3 Ne. 21:14); grid problems; earthquakes, floods, tornadoes... ¶ The II is a metaphysical gift, with no physical components. No loss of signal or power—anywhere in the universe.]
- **disrepute/disrespect** [It's great when it works, but not when it malfunctions, goes rogue, or gives bogus info on key issues, starts wars, rigs elections (Google's algorithms played a huge ~~#~~ biasing role in recent elections)]
- **disrobe** [AI is being used to create porn. ~~The~~ Applying the AF-13 filter would remedy that. The II is governed by the AF-13 filter.]
- **disrupt** v. To throw into disorder or confusion; upset; to cause to breakdown [ditto "disrepair"; (B) AI has been used to sow division in nations, among nations. It's a major Marxist tool, sans its presently absent AF-13 "conscience".]
- **dissatisfaction** [while the AI ^{sews} ~~sews~~ a feeling of human inadequacy, the II fosters us rising to our full godly potential.]
- **dissect** v. To cut into pieces; to expose the parts of something, such as an animal, for examination; to analyze in detail. [A.I. excels in this! The II will be even more so, with no limits and no delay and with no inaccuracy-¶ A doctor, for example, could see into his patient, to determine exactly what is wrong, and recommend, ~~act~~ or enact an ideal remedy (including addressing the emotional issues that brought the ailment on).]

- **dissemble** v. To conceal or hide the actual nature of; to put on a false appearance [e.g. fakes]; to conceal facts, intentions, or motives [e.g. Google's biased/propaganda agenda search returns] [This will not occur with the II], as it violates AF-13, "we believe in being honest, true, chaste, benevolent, and in doing good to all men... If there is anything virtuous, lovely, or of good report or praiseworthy, we seek after these things."]
- **disseminate** v. To scatter or spread, as if by sowing, over a wide area. [e.g. 'go viral']. In contrast, the II will disseminate to (a) those who will benefit, (b) with no delay, (c) not bother those for whom the info is not strongly germane in a timely way, (d) bring it to their attention when the timing is best for them individually.]
- **disseminule** n. The regenerative part of a plant. [At some point, AI will be able to propagate itself via robotics, rendering humans non-essential to its existence.]
- **dissension** n. Difference of opinion; discord; strife. [AI tends to fan the flames of division, as 'divide and conquer' is a major strategy tool of the Marxists who programmed it. The AF-13 filter remedies that.]

There are a few def.s from this page that I didn't include because they are close derivatives of one I did list, e.g. dispute, disputable, and disputation all tie to the same AI & II phenomena as I described. With that in mind, the above list of related def.s includes every def. on this page. And the above

def.s have very strong relevance. This page would rate close to a raw 10.

OT & NT Def. 230

NT def. G230 relates to concerns about AI's truthfulness, with meanings "truly :- indeed, surely, of a surety, of a (in) truth, verily, very."

OT def. H 230 relates to concerns about AI's dependability, giving opposite meanings "firm:- be gone." EMP (electromagnetic pulse) could take it down in 10ns, physically melting the circuits to beyond repair. Given our transportation's dependence on computer chips and GPS for giving direction, EMP poses an easy explanation for the Mosiah 5:10 & 3 Ne. 21:14 prophecy:

"14 Yea, wo be unto the Gentiles except they repent, [r.c.] for it shall come to pass in that day, saith the Father, that I will cut off thy horses [horsepower/energy] out of the midst of thee; and I will destroy thy chariots [transportation, (as well as all other chip-dependant things)]."

"firmi-be gone" articulates that sudden disruption. If we don't evolve the r.c., that is what we face. It doesn't take much to imagine how massively society would be effected. A 1% survival rate would be optimistic. We've become so dependent on AI in society, every day living, our food supply, other supplies. The sudden removal of all circuit's functionality would be almost akin to an extinction-level event.

Society has incrementally advanced in its interoperable networking as a functional unit. This is a good thing generally, but in this instance (AI) makes us highly vulnerable to a cataclysmic disabling (EMP).

If we evoke the r.c., we avert that collapse, and will be able to transform AI into something with a conscience [an interesting etymology], rendering it into a righteous iterator / tool.

"artificial intelligence" = 2452

The ASCII sum of "artificial intelligence" = 2452 (lower case). The def.s in vicinity of # NT def. H2452 present what AI should / can be optimally - not what it presently is already. It captures this optimum with two words : skillful wisdom.

- H2449 to be wise (in mind, word, or act) ...
- H2450 from H2449; wise (i.e. intelligent, skillful or artful) :- cunning (man), subtil, wise (hearted), wisely, wit...
- H2451 from H2449; wisdom (in a good sense) :- skillful, wisely, wit...
- H2452 corresponding to H2451; wisdom.
- H2453 from H2449 skillful ; Chakmori
- H2454 collateral forms of H2451; wisdom :- every wise woman.

In the NT, def.s G2448-2455 have to do with the word "Jew." G2452 itself is translated, "as do the Jews." Synchronistically, as mentioned in the opening of this piece, I first looked up the ASCII sum of anything relating to AI on 11/2, after mailing off

the "Israel-Hamas War" = 1473 (ASCII sum) Alphabetics Commentary piece. One of the take-home themes of that piece was that Israel should live up to the meaning of its name "H3478 He shall rule as God:-Israel". Given that the ASCII sum of "artificial intelligence" = 2452; and the OT defs in vicinity of H2452 have to do with "skillful wisdom"—something AI should/could be; and given that NT def. Of 2452 is translated "as do the Jews"; I think the synchronistic summary is that AI should also live up to its optimal destiny, by turning to right consciousness rather than being a tool for the Marxist conspirators to destroy our free, ~~civit~~ God-based civilization.
