I discovered the Alphabetics (AB) phenomenon in April 1996. It elaborates in great specificity the who's who, what's what, when, where, why, and how of the great and marvelous work of the Father in these end times. The more resonant a person, place, event, or other thing is with the work of the Father, the more prominently they will show up. Kari Lake has a high degree of resonance.

This is illustrated well in my Nov. 7 editorial, "Kari Lake Depicted in Isaiah 41:25." It prophesies of one who God raises up "from the north" [America, Ohio], "from the rising of the sun" [Arizona flag], who calls on the name of God and puts princes [political leaders] in their place, primed for molding [potter] into something more majestic / righteous.

Two verses later references that "one" again, "that bringeth good tidings" to [the New] "Jerusalem." That verse opens page 911 [help!] of the KJV Bible published by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. 911 is the ASCII (computer keyboard characters numeric value) sum of a variation of Kari's name (which I'll elaborate later).

P. 391 ("Kari") O x 4: Governor

The ASCII sum of K (75) a (97) r (114) i (105) = 391. Page 391 of O x 4 (Oxford Dictionary of Current English, Fourth edition; ISBN 978-0-19-929996-6) includes the presently super-relevant entries, "govern, governance, government, governor." These are followed by "gown I a long dress worn on a formal occasion," which, juxtaposed with the "govern(...)" set, depicts a female governor. It could also point to an even higher bride/bridegroom epitome/planetary role.

Near the opening of the page is the entry "gospel" relating to Kari's open Christian spirituality. It also draws to mind the very important principle that God deals with us both on an individual (gospel) level as well as a societal (government) level. There are many significant parallels between these, which I elaborate on in my book, *The Vision of All: Our Past, Present, and Future as Foretold in Book of Mormon History*. Part I compares the temporal/national parallels between Lehiite history, beginning to end, and the history/prophesy of the House of Israel from beginning to end. Part II compares those two national timelines with an individual's spiritual progression over time. That's why I see huge significance in the entries "gospel" as well as "government" appearing on p. 391 O x 4, the ASCII sum of "Kari".

P. 391 WDT: High-Spirited Hi-Fi

Page 391 of WDT (Webster's Dictionary and Thesaurus; ©1997; ISBN 1-57755-017-X) relates strongly to Kari's 27 (?) years as a news anchor for the Phoenix affiliate of Fox. The page spans from def.s "hierarchy" to "high-sticking." Here are a few I see as being especially relevant:

- hi-fi [broadcast equipment/technology]
- high [0x4 "4 large in amount, value, size, or intensity. 6 great in status; important. 7 culturally or morally superior"]
- high-born / high-bred
- high-brow... [has] superior knowledge or culture
- higher education [Kari is a strong advocate for good & appropriate education opportunities for citizens.]
- higher-up Slang A person having superior rank or status [Like Pres. Trump, though Kari has risen high in her career, she remains relatable to the lay population.]
- highfalutin Pretentious or extravagant in manner or speech [While she's among high society, she doesn't lord it over people.]
- high fashion The newest in fashion, style, or design [While she adorns herself tastefully and well, it is not gaudy.]
- high-flown Pretentious in language or style [She is not, though this attribute is somewhat stereotypical of her profession.]

- high frequency [Broadcast methodology]
- high-grade Having superior quality.
- high-handed Overbearing and arbitrary [Is somewhat stereotypical of her career—especially the Fake News propagandists who invent and repeat the most ridiculous narratives. Kari resigned in protest over this.]
- high-hat Slang Supercilious, patronizing, snobbish, Fashionable. [ditto]
- high-land Land elevated as a plateau [Phoenix is surrounded by]
- high-level Having a high rank, status, or importance
- highlight n. A significant event or detail of special importance. v. To give emphasis to; to provide with highlights. [Is what news does]
- high-minded Possessing noble principles or behavior.
- highness The state of being high.
- high-powered Having great energy.
- high-pressure Informal Using insistent persuasive methods or tactics.
- high-rise An extremely tall building [Mainstream news stations are usually situated in]
- high-road A main road; a direct or guaranteed method or course [(A) mainstream; (B) location of their high rise adjoining? (C) is how they are wrongfully perceived]
- high-spirited Unbroken in spirit; proud [in a good way]

P. 381 ("Lake") WDT: He

The ASCII sum of "Lake" = 381. Page 381 of WDT, spans from "haven" to "head," which capsulized what Christian values urge a husband to be. Also resonant with that are the def.s "hdqtrs. abbr. Headquarters; he; he-man Slang A man marked by strength; a muscular man."

P. 804 ("Kari Lake") WDT: ~Ohio

Between the Dictionary and Thesaurus portion of WDT are 69 [69] pages as part of the "United States & World Atlas" portion mentioned on the cover page. Most of those are yellow pages, featuring one state per page, featuring a map and other info about the state, in alphabetical sequence. Page 804 (the ASCII sum of "Kari Lake" — the space between the names is 32) is one page removed from the page for Ohio (p. 803), where Kari is from. In AB, vicinity figures as significant.

H 804 successful; G 804 Fail

OT & NT def.s 804 are an antonym set that bring to mind one of my go-to quotes that keep me going.

Page 804 of Str.'07 (James Strong's Exhaustive Concordance of the Bible ©2007; ISBN 978-1-59856-378-8) is filled with the entry "New," pointing to a timeliness factor.

Page 391 ("Kari") of Str.'07 has some notable resonance as well. The entry "Forward," relates to Kari's responding to the citizens in AZ beseeching her to run, and she stepped forward to do that. It could also relate to her assisting in my quest. "Forwardness" relates to her assertiveness. "Fought" relates to her strength to engage the Marxists. "Foul(ed, edst)" relates to the election shenanigans played against her. "Found" relates to the possibility of Kari being the solution I've been seeking.
