"S.V./New Jerusalem's air volume will be
17x Earth's air." = 4657 A/B Confirmation

The size of the N.J. given in Rev. 21:15
is 1500 miles³ — the width of the Gulf of Mexico,
and as wide and high. That's massive. It's 63%
as big as the volume of the moon! (radius 1084.6
miles). I can't help but think the ^{eight} corners of its
eight cube would just touch the perimeter of
the sphere of the moon if it were placed in-
side. It would be close. The reason why this
is fitting is that I believe the N.J. is the
Sky Venue (S.V.) that I talk about in my book, N→O.
We (ChaffB) design its modules and outsource to
its construction to our E.T. friends (Mos. 2:30
"millions of earths like this"), then we tip those levit-
ated (anti-gravity, powered by free energy) modules into
place and feather them together. ^{they are responsible for} We're building the venue
for the 1 Thes. 4:16,17 event where we're lifted up
in the air to be with Jesus. This is not a temporary
arrangement. "Thus shall we be ever with the Lord."

Therefore, for the S.V./N.J. to be approx-
imately the size to just fit within the sphere
same size of the moon, which orbits around the
earth. I don't see the S.V. orbiting. I see it
being levitated, able to be tipped wherever we
(ChaffB) want (AF 73). And as a logistical matter,

we'll need to flip it at least ~~the~~ three times a day so it doesn't cast a chilling shadow on the earth. At times of complete solar eclipse, the temperature will drop 10-20°F during the complete shadowing/blocking of the sun. If the S.V. were situated stationarily above one location — or if it ~~was~~ were built upon the earth and thus rotating with the earth, that shadow would last several hours. That is not sustainable.

The individually-levitated modules feathered together, like hummingbirds in formation, ^{model} explains how such a massive structure could be developed. It doesn't need a superstructure to hold things together. It's more like a collection of balloons.

Pondering on the massive size of the N.J. depicted in Rev. 21:16, ~~on~~ on 5/20, I thought of a fun question. The earth's atmosphere/air goes up 56 miles. Beyond that ~~is~~ ^{is} thin blue line is "space". The next time you see an image of the earth such as from the Space Station, notice that thin layer along the perimeter of the earth. The N.J. going up 1500 miles is far beyond that. So the question becomes, how ~~the~~ does the volume of air around the earth compare to the volume of air that will be aboard the N.J./S.V.?

In contrast, the largest building on earth is New Century Global Center, having 18.9 million ft^2 . Assuming a 12' floor height, it is $6.4 \times 10^8 \text{ m}^3$ compared to N.J. $1.4 \times 10^{19} \text{ m}^3$.

I ran this question by my atomic clock physicist / nation's timekeeper dad. Premise, the air aboard the N.J. / S.V. will be evenly distributed due to its modular nature, unlike the earth's air, which exponentially increases as you go down. My dad factored that exact equation (e^{-x}) ($1/e$). That correction adjusts the equally-distributed / concentrated air to just 5 miles above sea level for volume tabulation. With that adjustment, it turns out that the volume of air in the S.V. / N.J. will be 17 times the volume of air around the earth. \neq

Logistically, that means the breathable air in the S.V. will not be taken from earth's breathable air, but will be derived some other way (e.g. from a large number of compatible planets, or generated by electrolysis, etc...).

A follow-up question, considering the massive volume of the N.J., is how many people could the N.J. accommodate? The volume is $1.4 \times 10^{19} \text{ m}^3$ (cubic meters). To approximate how many people could live there, I assume a habitable volume of $3,000 \text{ ft}^2$, 10 ft high for each person, which is the size of a more than comfortable home for a family of six, with plenty of room for storage. (Cher's & my home in Eagle Mountain was that size.) Doing the simple math

on this says that the N.J. could fit 1.6×10^{16} people. That's 16,000,000,000,000,000 — 16 quadrillion. That's 1,818,181.81 times the 8.8 billion we have on earth now. That suggests that many of our 10^{49} E.T. friends will be hanging out there with us.

Not all the N.J./S.V. space/volume will be filled with living quarters. There will be office space, venues (theaters, dance halls, gardens, entertainment, recreation, etc...)

This size of a structure would impede / block most of the satellites orbiting the earth. However, the ~~S~~ IT will obsolete most if not all of that equipment. And tp will enable us to easily retrieve all of that equipment out of the orbital space.

Does that mean they (E.T. friends) haven't had anywhere to hang out until now? No. We're not the first planet to achieve attaining this S.V. They've been aggregating over time, gradually accumulating more and more modules from other planets that have attained the ~~st~~ o.c. and built a S.V. Only one aggregate is needed, given that we can tp to/from the S.V. to anywhere in the universe. Our additional volume-wise, to that venue will be relatively small. On 5/21, the day after I posed this question to my dad, I tabulated the ASCII sum of the above string. It turns out that this sum of 4657 has good resonance with this string that includes "S.V." in it.

Page 466 (4657/10) of Strong's '07 has page heading "Ground-Air", which summarizes the notion of earth-based / ground-based air being 12x on the S.V./N.J.
