## How Can a BoFM Believer Buy into the Mainstream News Narratives?

I'm directing this article to my inmate friend, Jeff, who has been nearby for much of the 7<sup>+</sup> years of my incarceration. His adamant opposition to Pres. Trump and the MAGA (Make America Great Again)

<\*5/28> movement baffles me. <\*> Like me, he's known for decades about the conspiracy to set up a global dictatorship ("New World Order" / "Great Reset"). His dad was a leader in a Federal agency deeply infiltrated with such conspirators. He informed Jeff about that, from his personal experience.

<5/29> What further perplexes me is that he loves Isaiah and the Book of Mormon (BoFM). Doesn't he see the warnings/prophesies there about this secret combination?

How could Jeff buy into the mainstream news narrative? One of the first things I learned was that the mainstream news is propaganda - which became blatantly obvious to me when I woke up to the existence of this conspiracy in my first year of graduate studies at BYU in 1987, after hearing Pres. Ezra Taft Benson's presentation at BYU, "The Constitution, A Heavenly Banner." I asked my roommate, Brian Jenkins, "Did he say socialism was good or bad?" I didn't know, having been completely naive until then. He had me read None Dare Call it Conspiracy by Gray Allen, which bore Pres. Benson's endorse-

ment on the back cover, as U.S. Secretary of Agriculture. He endorsed the book in a General Conference address, saying everyone should read it.

It would seem that Jeff would also understand the need to distrust the mainstream narrative/propaganda. In my mind, the word "propaganda" is rooted in lying or gaslighting - emphatically stating something repeatedly as fact - across many networks - that they know is not true, or which is lacking crucial clarifying information.

Perhaps the best example is the propaganda around George Floyd's death as a racial event, when in truth it was the Fertanyl that Floyd ingested that slowed his respirations, when he needed to be breathing faster. Hence his saying "I can't breathe" 4 x, when the four officers were trying to get him into the back of the squad car, which spurred a panic attack due to his claustrophobia.

The establishment jumped on this event, with its terrible optics, as a great tool for their divide-and-conquer agenda. Truth was not given a chance due to the mob furor they purposely stoked, intentionally ignoring truths that deflate their narrative. The mob narrative was so deeply seated that even most conservatives voices bought into the lies on that one.

I wouldn't expect Jeff to be an exception to

Where the puzzlement comes is on the obvious nasty fruits of the mainstream narratives: advocating abortion, as if a fetus isn't a person; promoting drag queens doing erotic dancing in front of children; promoting permanent alteration of a child's gender without parental involvement; condoning minor attracted persons fetishes; advocating open borders with all its child and drug trafficking as an acceptable loss for the gained Democratic voters and dependants, while further stressing an already precarious economy; pushing forced vaccination of an experimental jab that we now know to be massively problematic.

I don't see Jeff going for any of that. So, why does he give them any credence?

These people want the destruction of Free America that stands in the way of their global dictatorship that will be the ultimate Marxist hell—the Kingdom of Satan on earth — if we don't repent to avert that.<sup>(Eph. 8:26)</sup> They seek "to overthrow the freedom of all lands, nations, and countries; and [to bring] to pass the destruction of all people, for it is built up by the devil, who is the father of all lies..." (Eph. 8:25).

How can Jeff believe narratives coming from such wicked people? Because it's pop culture? Surely he knows the warnings to "go ye out from the midst of them" (Isa. 52:11); to not heed the clamorous derision of the Large & Spacious building. I guess this illustrates the
