

# ChofFB to Help Rule Universe —Tomorrow's World

I've been receiving the Living Church of God's free magazine, Tomorrow's World (.org), for about four years. I've been very impressed with most of their articles, as they apply the Bible and its principles to current events. It's something glaringly missing from The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, who could/do should do such a better job of this given the added light they have from the BFM and D&C, AGP. They're as salt that has lost its savor as prophesied <sup>e.g.</sup> in <sup>3 Ne 16:15</sup>. The "Liahona" magazine is light-weight, juvenile in comparison to Tomorrow's World. I read most every article in TW, but mostly just skim through Liahona.

TW is way off in their position/teaching that nothing happens between death and resurrection — egregiously incorrect on that one. But one area where they are very strong is in understanding the "joint heirs" concept that I elaborate on much further in my writings.

Their "Joining the Family Business" article in the Nov-Dec, 2023 issue, pp. 26,27 talks about how the joint heirs of Christ will help God rule the universe. That's a point I elaborate on in N-20 available from [EndComing.org](#). I say that incarnated here on earth are some of the most advanced souls from around the universe that among the planets like ours, I say there are  $10^{49}$  E.T. friends who have helped us grow to our present stature to pull off an ideal manifestation of the repartance clause

(r.c.) of prophecy. And that once we successfully pull this off, our destiny is to not only help provide leadership here on earth, but to also provide leadership among our 10<sup>49</sup> E.T. friends.

The very often cites the same verses I frequently cite, and they even set forth ones I've not yet noted as yet. Here's a sample from p.26.

The amazing truth revealed in your Bible is that God wants to share the 'family business' — rulership over the entire universe — with his children. As members of the very Family of God... [we] will actually share in the Work of God, assisting our Elder Brother, Jesus Christ, in teaching others, beautifying His creation, and governing the entire universe in peace and righteousness forever!"

It cites Rev. 2:25-26; 3:12,21; Heb. 2:5-7,8, pointing out that "all things" could be translated "the universe". It also cites Rom. 8:19-21. In other articles they often cite Rev.3:10 that talks about ruling as kings and priests on the earth. That's how this article opened.
